City of Commerce City, CO Sign Regulations Update

Plan Tools, in association with MDBR and Russell + Mills Studios, overhauled and updated the City of Commerce City Sign Regulations. Adopted in 2022, the updated Commerce City Sign Regulations mark the eleventh sign code updated by a Plan Tools team since the 2015 Supreme Court decision regarding content neutrality (Reed v Town of Gilbert, AZ).

Highlights of the City of Commerce City Sign Regulations Update include:

• Restructured code format with similar provisions consolidated for clarity and ease of use.

• Graphics created include illustrations and photos depicting sign measurement and sign types.

• Tables created that consolidate and organize text; for example, each sign type section has a table with standards listed by use category.

• Updated sign standards reflect best practices and contemporary technology, e.g., electronic message centers.

• New and/or updated sign and sign-related definitions.

• Legal compliance for content-neutrality.
