City of Lakewood, CO CPD Organizational Effectiveness Study

Plan Tools, LLC, working in conjunction with Core Learning Matters, Inc. and Sky to Ground LLC, prepared an organizational effectiveness study for the City of Lakewood's Community Planning and Development Department (CPD).

Completed in May, 2009, the focus of the study is to understand the issues that are contributing to current levels of CPD's performance, and to develop recommendations for how to capitalize on CPD's strengths and address issues that could stand in the way of the organization's success.

Plan Tools evaluated CPD as a system consisting of five components:

- 1. Core Activities
- 2. Organizational Structure
- 3. Regulatory Framework
- 4. Information Technology
- 5. Physical Space

The findings and recommendations presented in the study were used to help the CPD organization develop action plans that improve its ability to focus on goals, to embody the values of the City, to attract and retain key employees and to consistently provide the highest level of service.
